7. Mary Warren gives Elizabeth a poppet.

9. Mary Warren testifies against the other girls.	
10. Elizabeth Proctor lies about her husband's infidelity.

12. Abigail vanishes from Salem with Reverend Parris's money.	
13. Giles Corey refuses to confess to witchcraft.	
14. Danforth refuses to delay the executions.	
15. John Proctor tears up his confession.
